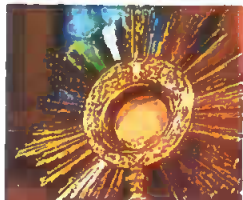

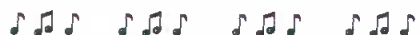
Diocesan Corpus Christi Procession June 10th, 2012
