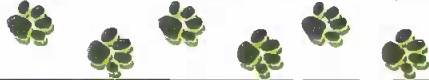
► We are currently enrolling for grades PreK3 through 8th Grade – registration packets are available in the school office, stop by and see what we have to offer.

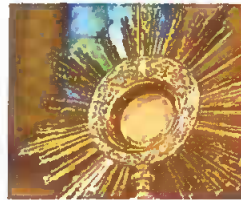
