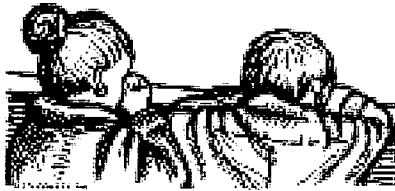


Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

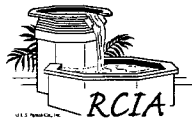
COMING THIS ADVENT!

A special program is being planned for the Advent season at St. Therese. This program will be based on Fr. Robert Barron's inspiring DVD series "Conversion: Responding to God's Call." The series considers six Biblical figures who responded in various ways to God's call. Each of these examples provides an important lesson for us as we seek to recognize and respond to God's call in our own lives today.

Themes from the series will be incorporated into Fr. Norbert's weekly homilies to stimulate reflection and to promote the practical application of the central ideas. The anticipated result of this program is not only personal spiritual preparation for the Christmas season but also a strengthening of our parish community.
