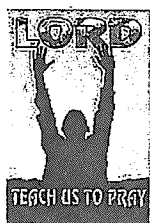
TRAINING GOOD STEWARDS

PRAYING FOR VOCATIONS



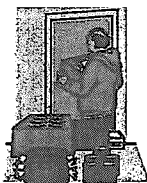
