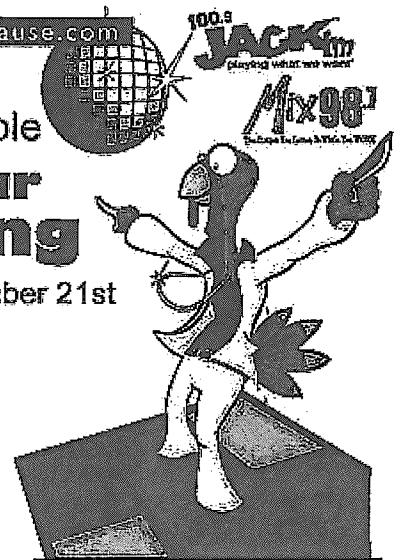

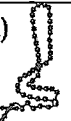

So on behalf of Fr. Norbert, thank you - you are so appreciated!

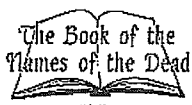

YEAR OF FAITH ENDS

► Last year, Pope Benedict XVI decreed that the Catholic Church will observe the Year of Faith between October 11, 2012 and November 24, 2013.

► Saturday, November 23rd, St. Therese will offer Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 12Noon until 4pm in the Chapel.

► As part of the Year of Faith observance, Bishop Latino has designated The Cathedral of St. Peter the Apostle as one of the Year of Faith churches. Those who make a pilgrimage to pray or worship at St. Peter on Nov. 24 are eligible for a plenary indulgence after fulfilling the normal requirements for an indulgence. Confessions will be heard prior to all Masses on the weekend of Nov.23-24 at the Cathedral.

Marking the end of the Year of Faith and the Feast of Christ the King, a Diocesan Eucharistic Procession will be held at St. Richard on Sunday, Nov. 24 beginning at 2pm.
