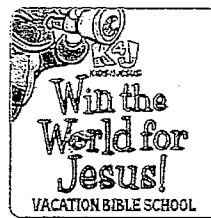
Catholic Service Appeal 2015

Pro-Life Mississippi's Annual Walk 4 Life

This year's walk will be held on Saturday, May 9th, and will again be sponsored by St. Richard's Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus. Meet at St. Richard's Catholic Church located at 1242 Lynnwood Dr, Jackson, MS 39206 at 7:00 a.m. for registration, and the walk will begin at 7:30 a.m. [Walking west on Lynnwood Dr., turning left onto Manhattan Rd., then left onto Meadowbrook Rd., right onto Old Canton Rd., right onto Duling St., and left onto N. State St. We will pray at the abortion clinic at 2903 N. State St.,] and then walk back the same route to St. Richard's. There will be a water station at the abortion clinic. We will have a short prayer and release balloons in honor of all the babies who have died there from abortion. The walk is two miles each way for a total of four miles.
