

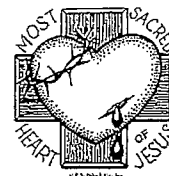

Father's Day - A Special Second Collection

A special second collection is scheduled on the weekend of Father's Day (June 20-21) to supplement the pension given to diocesan Priests of retirement age. This collection takes place on Father's Day each year. Parishioners should make any checks payable to their parish, and pastors should assure that the proceeds of the collection are combined into one check and mailed to the Chancery Office.

What is the purpose of this collection?

Priests of the Diocese of Jackson (who do not belong to religious orders) are provided with a modest pension in their golden years by an endowment to which parishes pay a yearly assessment. In addition, Priests who are seniors receive a small pension supplement from the Catholic Service Appeal.

With a larger number of Priests nearing retirement age and a decline in investment returns, the endowment is not expected to keep pace with increasing costs of living. Instead of asking parishes to increase their yearly contribution to the endowment, the Diocese has opted to have a special collection for our retired Priests on Father's Day.

The proceeds of this Father's Day collection will be used to increase the Diocese's pension supplement.

As we honor fathers, please consider a generous gift to assure a worthy pension/retirement for your spiritual father. May your generosity and the grateful prayers of our Priests be a source of abundant blessings for you and your loved ones.

Isn't there already a collection for retired Priests?

There are two annual special collections that are sometimes confused with one another, and neither one meets the specific need of providing diocesan Priests with an adequate pension/retirement.

1. **The first is the collection** to support retired religious. "Religious" refers to women (sisters, nuns) and men (brothers and some Priests) who belong to religious communities such as Dominicans, Benedictines, Franciscans, etc. Diocesan Priests are distinct from religious Priests and do not benefit from this collection.
2. **The other yearly second collection** is for "aged and infirm Priests." This collection is optional and the amount collected is held by each parish to offset insurance costs/medical expenses of Priests, but does not provide for a pension or a retired Priest's day-today expenses.

Human Trafficking is A CRIME AGAINST HUMANITY a form of MODERN-DAY SLAVERY that affects people from all walks of life. It is one of the fastest growing crimes in the world and the second largest criminal enterprise, after drugs. Human Trafficking has been identified in several Mississippi communities and child sex trafficking has also been identified in Hinds, Madison, Rankin and Warren counties and the average age of victims is 12-14 years of age—

with “travel corridors” in Corinth, Southaven, Jackson, Meridian, Hattiesburg, and the Gulf Coast.

Awareness is the first step in the fight to END this crime against the sanctity of human life.

Awareness of the crime of human trafficking is the first step to eradicating modern slavery.

Parishioners are encouraged to participate in this FREE Human Trafficking Awareness Workshop on June 27 to discover ways to help end this abuse of human life. Components of the workshop include a keynote speaker, a thorough overview of Human Trafficking, it's prevalence in Mississippi and practical steps for involvement.


