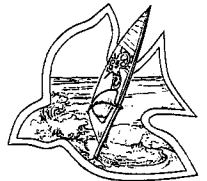
► **June 25 - 4:00pm Confirmation Mass at St. Therese with Bishop Kopacz, a light reception will follow.**
