THE POSITION requires a leader to inspire and manage a staff of social service and clinical professionals; oversee the budget and financial affairs; aid in raising funds to maintain and expand services; manage the hiring, training, and evaluation of Agency personnel; communicate to the public the services and needs of the organization; report to and collaborate with the Executive Director and the Board of Directors, and consult with the Governance Council. A competitive salary and benefits package is offered.

QUALIFICATIONS include: Master's degree in social work or a related mental health field with 5-7 years of non-profit management experience, preferably in a Catholic social services agency; experience managing a diverse staff and client population; experience in fundraising and finance; outstanding communication and interpersonal skills.

THE ORGANIZATION provides assistance in domestic violence, rape crisis, housing, addiction recovery, adoption, children's mental health and crisis services, individual and family counseling, immigration services, therapeutic foster care, unaccompanied refugee minor services, veteran services, and legislative advocacy. Catholic Charities is accredited by the Council on Accreditation and licensed by the Mississippi Department of Child Protection Services and the Mississippi Department of Mental Health. The Agency has a staff of 170 and an annual budget of about \$9 million.
