Thomas Merton, Spiritual Writer and Contemplative Aug. 10-11

Thomas Merton (1915 – 1968), an American Trappist monk, is considered one of the most influential spiritual writers of the 20th century. He has written more than 70 books and numerous essays, poems, and reviews.

When Pope Francis addressed a joint session of Congress in September of 2015, Fr. Merton, OSCO, was mentioned as an American writer that we all should be currently reading. Fr. Merton's autobiography, *The Seven Storey Mountain*, made the National Review's list of the 100 best non-fiction books of the 20th century. Thomas Merton died accidentally in 1968. Since his death, his work continues to be studied by both ordinary lay people as well as theologians.

During this retreat, we will look at Merton's historical life and conversion to Christianity. We will also look into essays that Merton wrote for the laity on solitude and contemplation. Coupled with these discussions will be some practical discussion on these sometimes, thick subjects. Presenter: Ed Thebaud is a passionate admirer and scholar of Merton.
