"The Interior Castle" July 19-20

Come spend some time in reflection on St. Teresa of Avila's great work, "The Interior Castle." Written in 1577, it is a guide by Teresa, one of the Great Doctors of the Church, on how to deepen our relationship with God through the steps of Purgation, Illumination and Union.

St. Teresa describes how the soul is like a diamond in the shape of a castle that contains seven mansions.

The mansions are symbolic of the seven stages of a journey of faith which culminates in 'union with God.' Even though these words were written nearly 450 years ago, St. Teresa's wisdom is just as applicable and practical today.
